

## 691 Hawk Wine Survivor Raffle Rules

- 1. Each individual entrant will pay a fee of \$20 cash plus contribute a bottle of wine with an approximate value of \$13 before provincial taxes. We will accept a maximum of 300 entries into the raffle.
- 2. The wine must be bottled and sealed commercially (not homemade nor through a wine kit).
  - 1. Submitter Name, Phone Number and e-mail address must be provided
  - 2. Receipt for wine is preferred and appreciated.
  - 3. There is no limit to the number of entries per person.
  - 4. All bottles submitted are tagged with a number.
  - 5. By donating \$35 to cover your participation fee and the cost of a bottle of wine that #691 Hawk Parent Support Group will purchase on your behalf.
- 3. One can participate as part of a team or as an individual and a team will be assigned to you. Organizers will ensure that the total number of entries is divisible evenly by 5. Any entries that cannot be assigned to a team will be refunded. Individuals may enter more than once, and each entry will be treated as a separate entry.
- 4. Each team will have one person designated as team captain. The team captain is responsible for notifying other team members when their team has been eliminated, and distributing prizes if the team is a winner.
  - 1. Participants entering as individuals must agree to have their name, phone number and email shared with the team captain for communication purposes.
- 5. Entries will be accepted until Noon November 30, 2019.
- 6. As in the TV Show Survivor, participants are expelled until only the winner remains. Expulsion draws will start on Monday, December 2, 2019 and will be held daily until Friday, December 6 until only 10 entries remain. The final 10 will be drawn at the Parent Support Group meeting on Monday, December 9, 2019.
  - 1. As names are drawn, that person is expelled, but may still be on a winning team.
  - A team is eliminated when all team members have been expelled. Approximately 1/5 of the teams will be eliminated each day. Draws will continue until all teams have been eliminated except 1.
  - 3. The final team remaining is the First Place Winner; the second-last team to be eliminated is the Second Place Winner, and so on. Prizes are awarded for final 5 teams, as well as a consolation prize for the first team eliminated.
- 7. All entrants will be notified daily via Facebook Live post and/or email of the draw results on each of the 5 draw days. The final draws and announcement of winning teams will be made at the regular meeting of the #691 Hawk Squadron Parent Support Group on December 9, 2019. Team captains will be notified by phone or email if not in attendance. Prizes will be

available for pick up by the team captains on that date, or at a mutually agreed alternate date and location. It is the responsibility of the team captain to arrange delivery to team members.

- 8. Prizes are awarded to teams as follows, based on 300 bottles:
  - 1. 1st place 100 bottles of wine, to be distributed equally to each team member
  - 2. 2nd place 70 bottles of wine, to be distributed equally to each team member
  - 3. 3rd place 55 bottles of wine, to be distributed equally to each team member
  - 4. 4th place 40 bottles of wine, to be distributed equally to each team member
  - 5. 5th place 25 bottles of wine, to be distributed equally to each team member
  - 6. Consolation to first team eliminated 10 bottles of wine, to be distributed equally to each team member.
- 9. If the total number of entrants, and bottles of wine, are less than 300, prizes will be adjusted to the number of entries.
- 10. Draws will be made at the Indian Head Memorial Hall, 423 Grand Avenue, Indian Head Saskatchewan. Draws will be conducted by a minimum of 3 members of the #691 Hawk Squadron Parent Support Group.
- 11. No person under the age of 19 years of age may enter the raffle. The ticket will indicate that a purchaser must not write down the name of a person under age 19.
- 12. All bottles of wine received as entry fees will be distributed as prizes. No cash prizes will be awarded. All cash received as entry fees will be retained by the #691 Hawk Squadron as proceeds of the raffle.
- 13. Payment for the \$20 entry fee may be made by cash or cheque. One bottle of wine per entry must be submitted at the time the entry fee is paid. If you want the group to purchase the wine for you, we will accept an EFT for \$35.00 to 691europe2021@gmail.com with password is "691wine".
- 14. There are no restrictions on the participation of members, families, volunteers, etc., of the #691 Hawk Squadron PSG.
- 15. If 300 tickets are not sold by November 30, 2019, the #691 Hawk Squadron reserves the right to request a draw extension or cancellation from the Saskatchewan Gaming and Liquor Commission.
- 16. Unclaimed prizes will be held in a secure location for one year and if unclaimed during this year, prizes or cash equivalent will be donated to a charitable beneficiary approved by SLGA.
- 17. The #691 Hawk Squadron and the Saskatchewan Gaming Commission are not responsible for any disputes which may arise between the different individuals who have chosen to enter the raffle.
