

OPERATION EVERGREEN KIT LIST

Mandatory

Tooth brush	hairbrush or comb	jacket
Toothpaste	Socks x1 pair per day	sun screen / bug spray
Shampoo / Conditioner	Pants/shorts x1 per day	sweater
Soap	Shirt x2 per day	water bottle
Shower Towel	Pajamas	pillow
Shower Shoes (i.e. flip flops)	underwear x1 per day	sleeping bag
Shaving Kit (if required)	hat	prescription medications (as required)

Sunglasses	Flashlight	Other personal items
Notebook	entertainment for bus ride	lip balm

*Should you not have a sleeping bag, please see Lt Drew or Capt Walton as we can generally arrange to loan one out to you.

*Cadets need to be prepared for the weather. As we are going in the fall, it can be hot during the days and be cool in the morning/evenings. It is imperative cadets dress in layers.

ITEMS PROHIBITED

The following items are prohibited or not allowed and shall not be brought to the training centre under any circumstances. Ref. [CATO 12-50 Annex B](#), Prohibited, Restricted and Unauthorized Items. These items will be confiscated and may be handed to the applicable police agency or disposed of if brought to the training centre:

Knives, laser pointers, lighters or other fire starting equipment, Firearms (any kind), Non-Prescribed and illicit drugs, Alcoholic beverages, Tobacco/Cannabis, products Vaping paraphernalia.

The following items are brought at cadet's own risk:

1. Smart phones / Cellular Phones;
2. iPads, MP3 players; and
3. Tablets / laptop computers.

To eliminate any storage of valuables, or security problems, it is recommended that cadets do not bring jewelry, or other "attractive items" to the CTC. Cadets who bring valuables to CTC are to complete the Record of Valuable Items (Annex B) form, in these Joining Instructions, and return a completed copy of the form to 691 Staff.
